Notice is hereby given of a public participation process in accordance with the procedures for a Section 24G Application for Rectification in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (Act 107 of 1998)/NEMA 2014 as amended)
Listed Activities: The application for rectification relates to the unauthorised commencement of the following listed activities under NEMA 2014 (as amended), namely: GNR 324/12, GNR 325/16, GNR 327/12, 19, 27, 48, 50 & 63.
Project Location & Description:
 The unauthorized commencement of listed activities for which rectification is applied for occurred on the Farm Matjes Gatt 140/RE-1, near Greyton, for the following reasons: Financial viability of Oewerzicht Trust consists of farming with multi-annual fruit trees under summer irrigation. During 2018 the farm had only 17868m3 water storage capacity. The Trust has an existing licensed winter water allocation from the Riverosderend that may only be taken from 1 May to 30 October each year. Due to the unprecedented 4-consecutive years drought situation in the Western Cape at the time, the Trust had no other alternative but to commence with the construction of the Oewerzicht Dam during April 2018 without environmental authorisation, in order to create storage capacity for the storage of said winter water for use as summer irrigation. This was done to ensure the future financial viability of the farming operation if the drought would persist for another season or more. At the time planning existed to construct the dam in 2020, so the dam was already designed. A specialist freshwater study was also completed to determine, manage and mitigate possible environmental impacts. The emergency construction inundated the two existing small dams, was overseen by a Professional Person registered under the National Water Act and constructed by a reputable and experienced contractor. The dam was partly constructed and partly filled with water from the existing water right by pumping from the Riverosderend, until the activity was terminated by Water Affairs. The part construction was carried out under an environmental management plan and overseen by a qualified and experienced environmental control officer.
