1. Standard Conditions of Quotation:

The following conditions will apply:

- a) Quotations must be completed in hand written non-erasable black ink.
- b) Price(s) quoted must be valid for at least sixty (60) days from the date of your offer.
- Price(s) quoted must be firm and must be inclusive of VAT, clearly indicating Price, VAT and Total Price.
- d) The goods must be delivered within one (1) week from date of official order.
- e) This quotation will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference point system as prescribed in the Preferential Procurement Regulations of 2017 and for this purpose MBD 2, MBD 4, MBD 6.1, MBD 6.2, MBD 8 and MBD 9 forms which are available on the Municipal Website www.twk.gov.za must be completed and submitted together with your quotation.
- f) The successful provider will be the one scoring the highest points.
