If posted, interested Contractors to ensure that sufficient time are given for the post to reach us before the closing date and time. Council cannot responsibility for any delays.

The following conditions will apply:

- Quotations must be completed in hand writing with black ink.
- Price(s) quoted must be valid for at least sixty (60) days from date of your offer.
- Price(s) quoted must be firm and must be inclusive of VAT, clearly indicating Price, VAT and Total Price
- The goods must be delivered within two (2) weeks from date of official order.
- This quotation will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference point system as prescribed in the Preferential Procurement Regulations of 2022 and for this purpose the MBD 2, MBD 4, MBD 6.1, MBD 8 & MBD 9 forms which are available on the Municipal Website www.twk.gov.za must be completed and submitted together with your quotation subject to the test for administrative compliance.
- The successful provider will be the one scoring the highest points.
- A Valid Tax Clearance Pin Certificate and a copy of your latest Municipal Account must be attached to your quotation.
- Council may accept a quotation in full, partially or not at all.
- Payments will be made not later than 30 days, after the receipt of a tax invoice.
- Invoices must not be issued before goods / services have been supplied / rendered.
- Calculation errors will be corrected by the Municipality by using the unit prices.
- The General Conditions of Contract for construction works will apply to this quotation inclusive of the mandatory Sec. 37(2) Agreement between client and bidder.
- If a valid B-BBEE certificate, EME or QSE affidavit is not attached, it will be interpreted that the preference points for B-BBEE status level or contribution are not claimed.

MBD 2 - TAX CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS

PREFERENCE POINTS CLAIM FORM IN TERMS OF THE PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS 2022

This preference form must form part of all tenders invited. It contains general information and serves as a claim form for preference points for specific goals.

1. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1.1 The following preference point systems are applicable to invitations to tender:

1.2 To be completed by the organ of state

- 1.3 Points for this tender (even in the case of a tender for income-generating contracts) shall be awarded for:
 - (a) Price; and
 - (b) Specific Goals.

- 1.6 The organ of state reserves the right to require of a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.

2. DEFINITIONS

- (a) "tender" means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation to provide goods or services through price quotations, competitive tendering process or any other method envisaged in legislation;
- (b) "price" means an amount of money tendered for goods or services, and includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (c) "rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;
- (d) "tender for income-generating contracts" means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and a third party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and
- (e) "the Act" means the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000).

MBD 9 - CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION
