#### 1. Standard Conditions of Quotation:

#### The following conditions will apply:

- a) Quotations must be completed in hand writing with black ink.
- b) Prices must be valid for at least sixty (60) days from closing of the quotation.
- c) Price(s) guoted must be firm and must be inclusive of VAT, clearly indicating Price, VAT and Total Price.
- d) The goods must be delivered within two (2) months of date of official order.
- e) This quotation will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference point system as prescribed in the
- f) Preferential Procurement Regulations of 2017 and for this purpose the MBD 2, MBD 4, MBD 6.1, MBD 6.2, MBD 8 & MBD 9 forms which are available on the Municipal Website www.twk.gov.za must be completed and submitted together with your quotation subject to the test for administrative compliance.
