1. Standard Conditions of Quotation:

The following conditions will apply:

- a) Quotations must be completed in hand writing with black ink.
- b) Price(s) quoted must be valid for at least sixty (60) days from date of your offer.
- c) Price(s) quoted must be firm and must be inclusive of VAT, clearly indicating Price, VAT and Total Price.
- d) The goods must be delivered within 1 week from date of official order.
- e) This quotation will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference point system as prescribed in the Preferential Procurement Regulations of 2017 and for this purpose MBD 2, MBD 4, MBD 6.1, MBD 6.2, MBD 8 and MBD 9 forms which are available on the Municipal Website www.twk.gov.za must be completed and submitted together with your quotation.

 - (a) disqualify the person from the bidding process;
 - (b) recover costs, losses or damages it has incurred or suffered as a result of that person's conduct;
 - (c) cancel the contract and claim any damages which it has suffered as a result of having to make less favourable arrangements due to such cancellation;
 - (d) recommend that the bidder or contractor, its shareholders and directors, or only the shareholders and directors who acted on a fraudulent basis, be restricted by the National Treasury from obtaining business from any organ of state for a period not exceeding 10 years, after the audi alteram partem (hear the other side) rule has been applied; and
 - (e) forward the matter for criminal prosecution.

CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION

- 1 This Municipal Bidding Document (MBD) must form part of all bids¹ invited.
- Section 4 (1) (b) (iii) of the Competition Act No. 89 of 1998, as amended, prohibits an agreement between, or concerted practice by, firms, or a decision by an association of firms, if it is between parties in a horizontal relationship and if it involves collusive bidding (or bid rigging).² Collusive bidding is a *pe se* prohibition meaning that it cannot be justified under any grounds.

Bid rigging is, therefore, an agreement between competitors not to compete.
