- Must be unemployed and actively looking for work.
- Able to perform physical duties where necessary
- 18 years and older
- Preference will be given to individuals from indigent households with no source of income, upon submission of proof confirming indigent status.

2. Originally certified copy of Grade 9 (or NQF1 equivalent) (Waste Water Operators and Plumbers)
3. Proof of address
4. Proof of banking details (upon appointment) and SARS Number

Minimum Requirement for Plumbers

Grade 9 (or NQF1 equivalent) – **Proof must accompany application form.**

Basic understanding of the work done by Plumbers.

Must have at least 2 years' experience in pipelaying

Minimum Requirements for General workers

The most eligible candidate must have basic literacy with 0 – 1 year experience (***experience must be clearly stated in the application form***). Good human relations. Appointment also requires a hard-working person who can work well within a team. Good physical health is essential.

Minimum Requirements for Operators Wastewater Treatment

Grade 9 (or NQF1 equivalent)

Candidates must show specific interest in working on a wastewater treatment plant and participate in an in-house training programme. The project aims to give in-house training to EPWP workers to obtain an Operator's Certificate at the end of the project. Candidates need to have good human relations with fellow workers. The position requires hard-working persons who works well with-in a team and show high levels of commitment and integrity to participate in this programme.

Please note: No e-mailed, scanned or faxed applications will be accepted, and shortlisted candidates will be required to produce original copies of academic qualifications on the day of the interview. Only original applications forms will be accepted.
