After completing our project at the Klipkop Estate, we received our first grass cutting project. We were asked to cut the grass in and around the Pineview Park Sports Grounds.

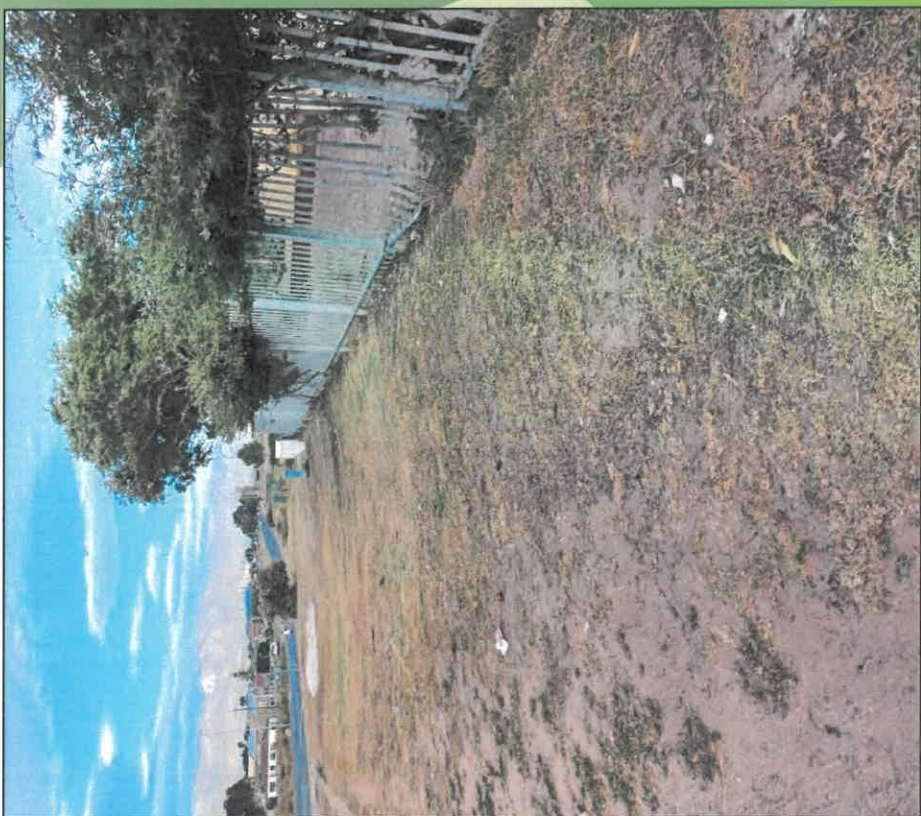


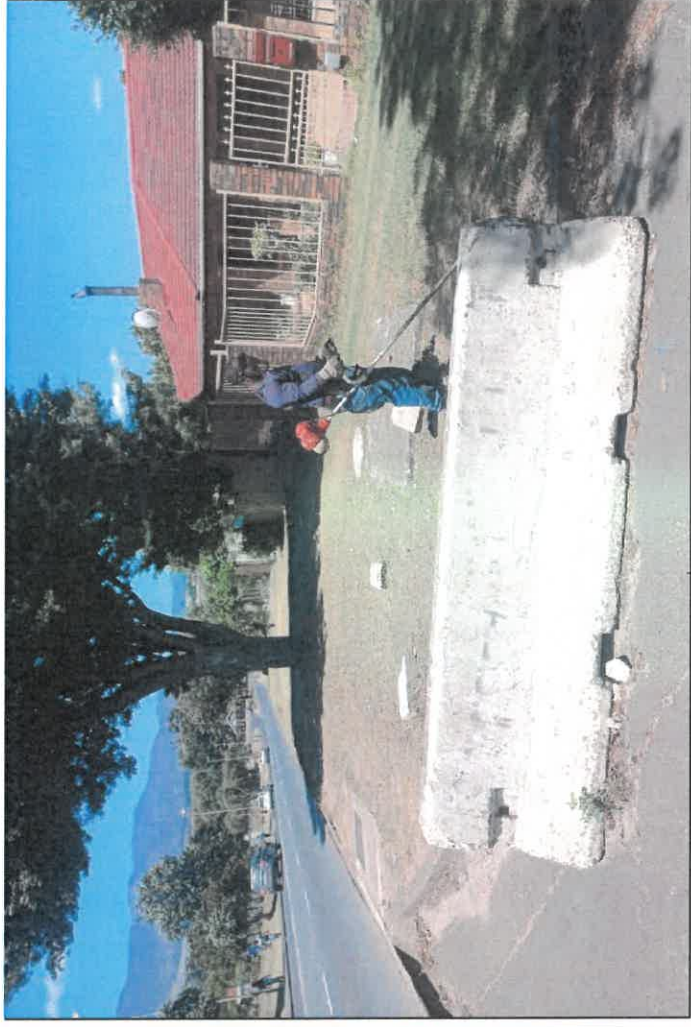

- During the time we were busy cleaning at this area vehicles stop and thanked us for the great work we are busy doing, they are already seeing excellent results next to the N2.

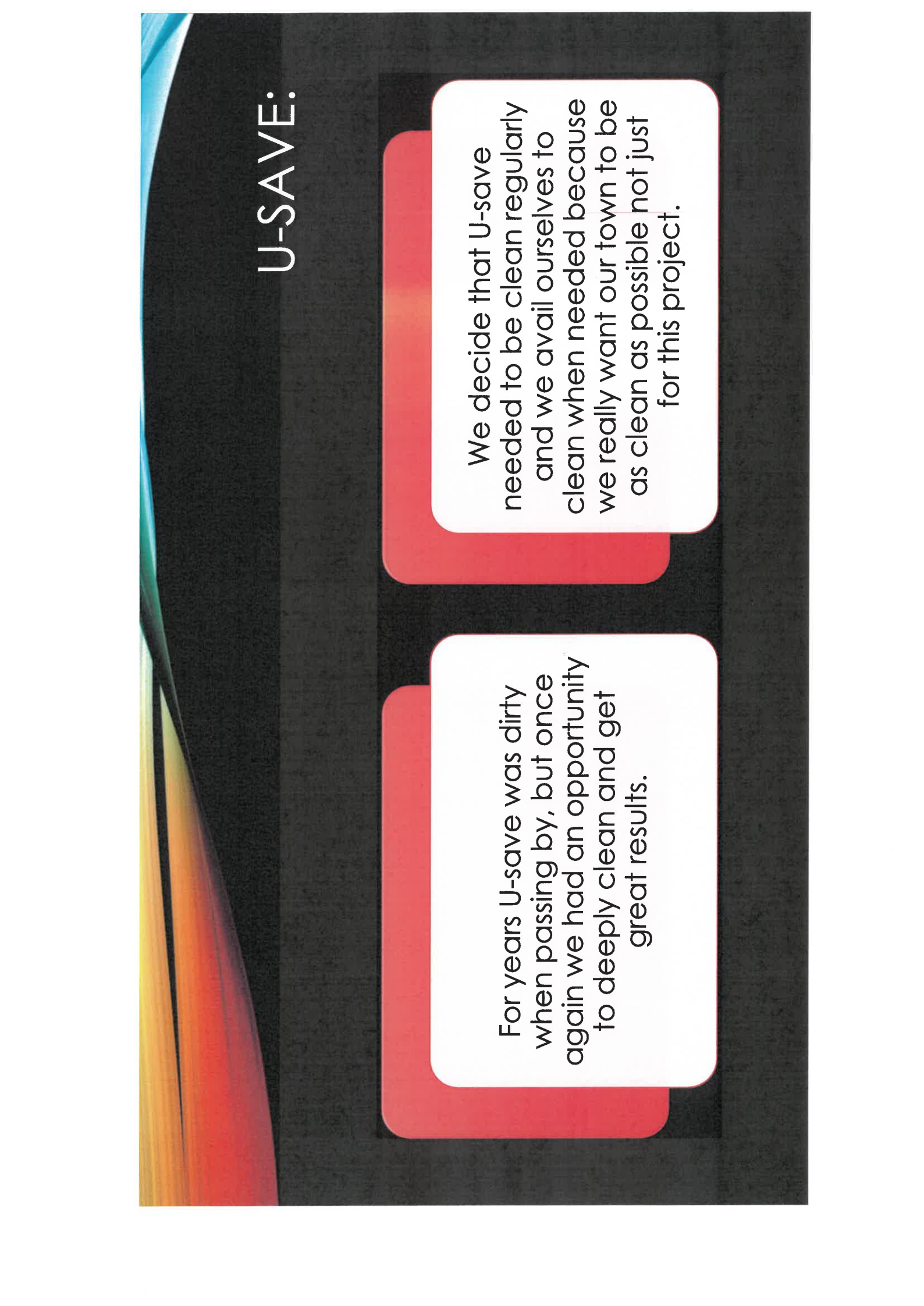


MELROSE:

We know that Melrose Place is one of the areas with a lot of garbage.



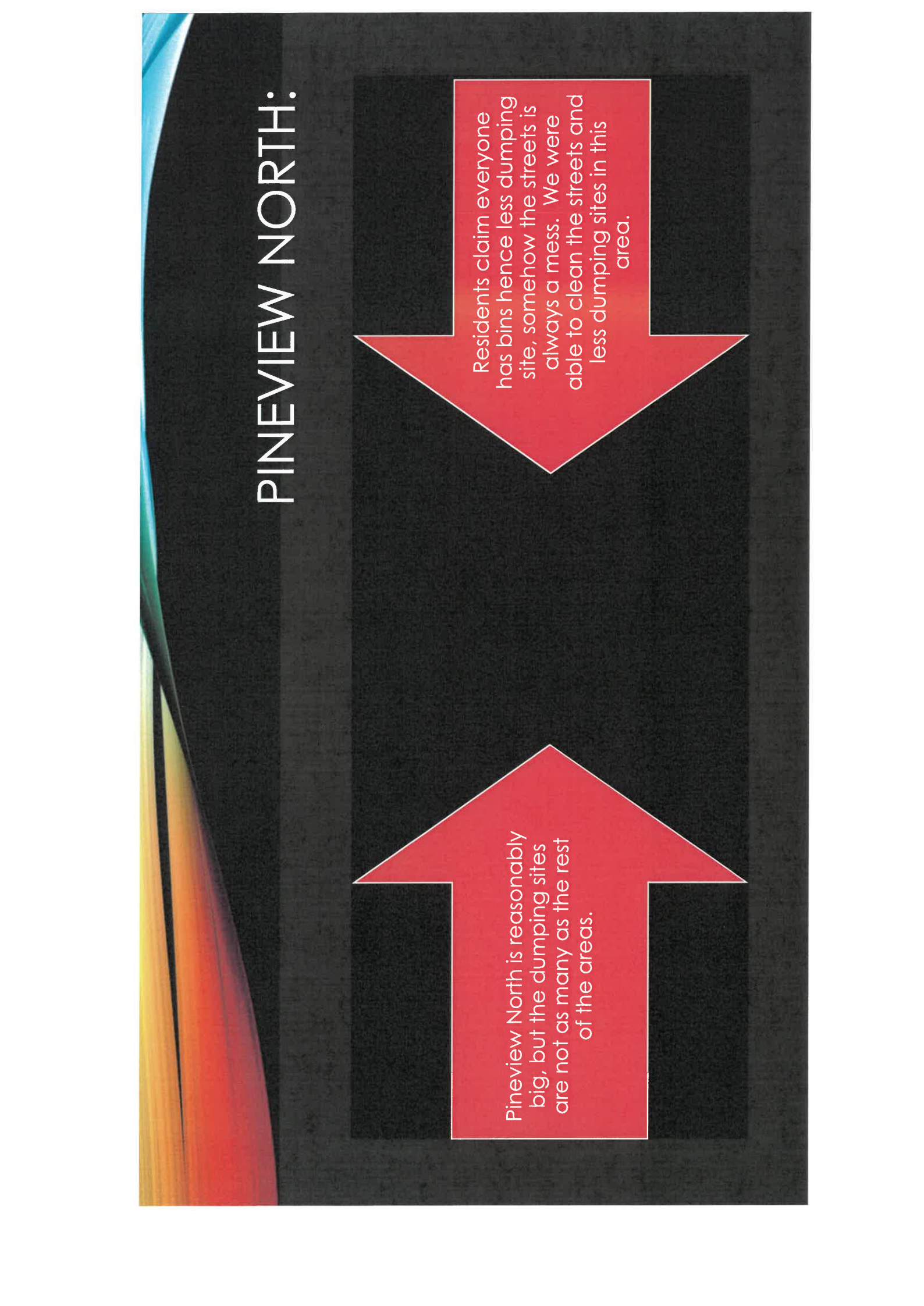
Residents and surrounded tuck shops thanked the workers for the job they have been doing and were ecstatic and proud about the clean spaces.

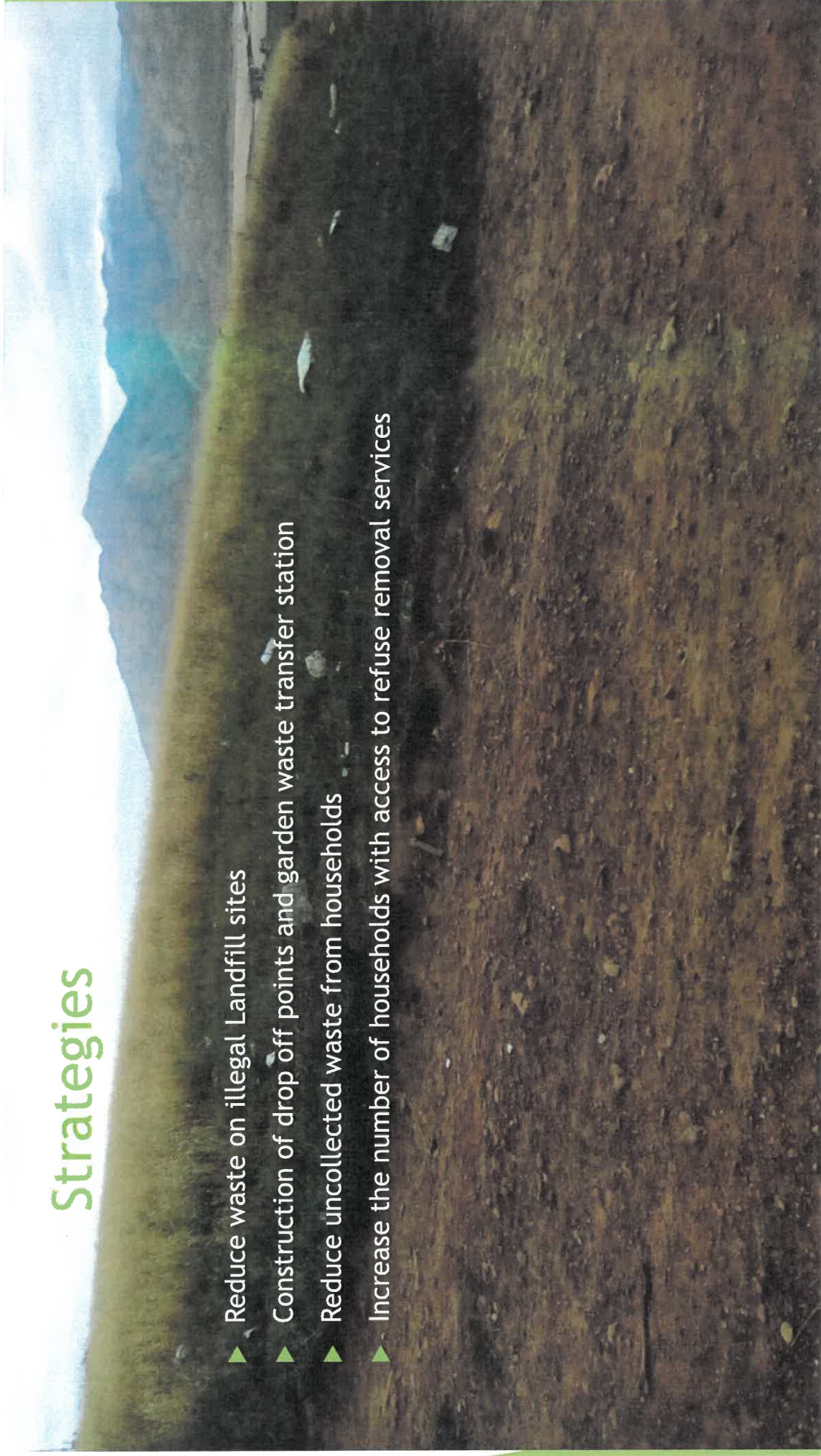
- To ensure that all TWKM citizens live in a clean, safe and healthy environment by providing an efficient and effective Solid Waste Management Services

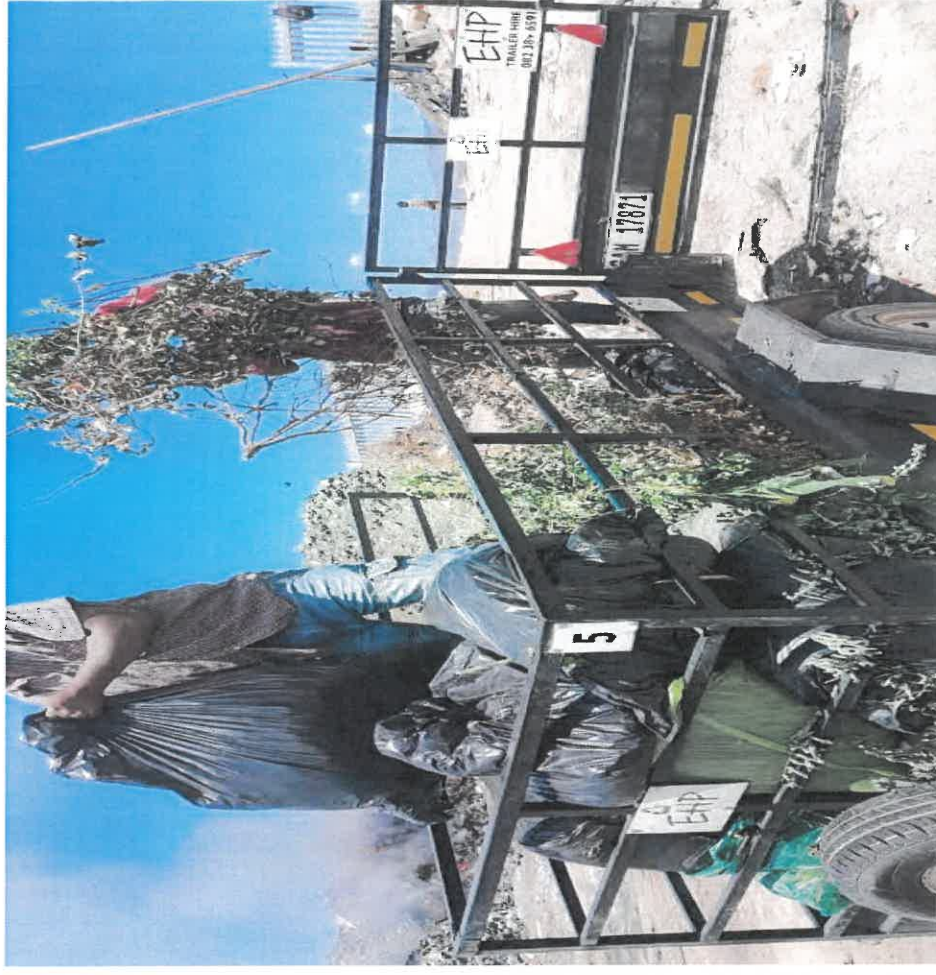

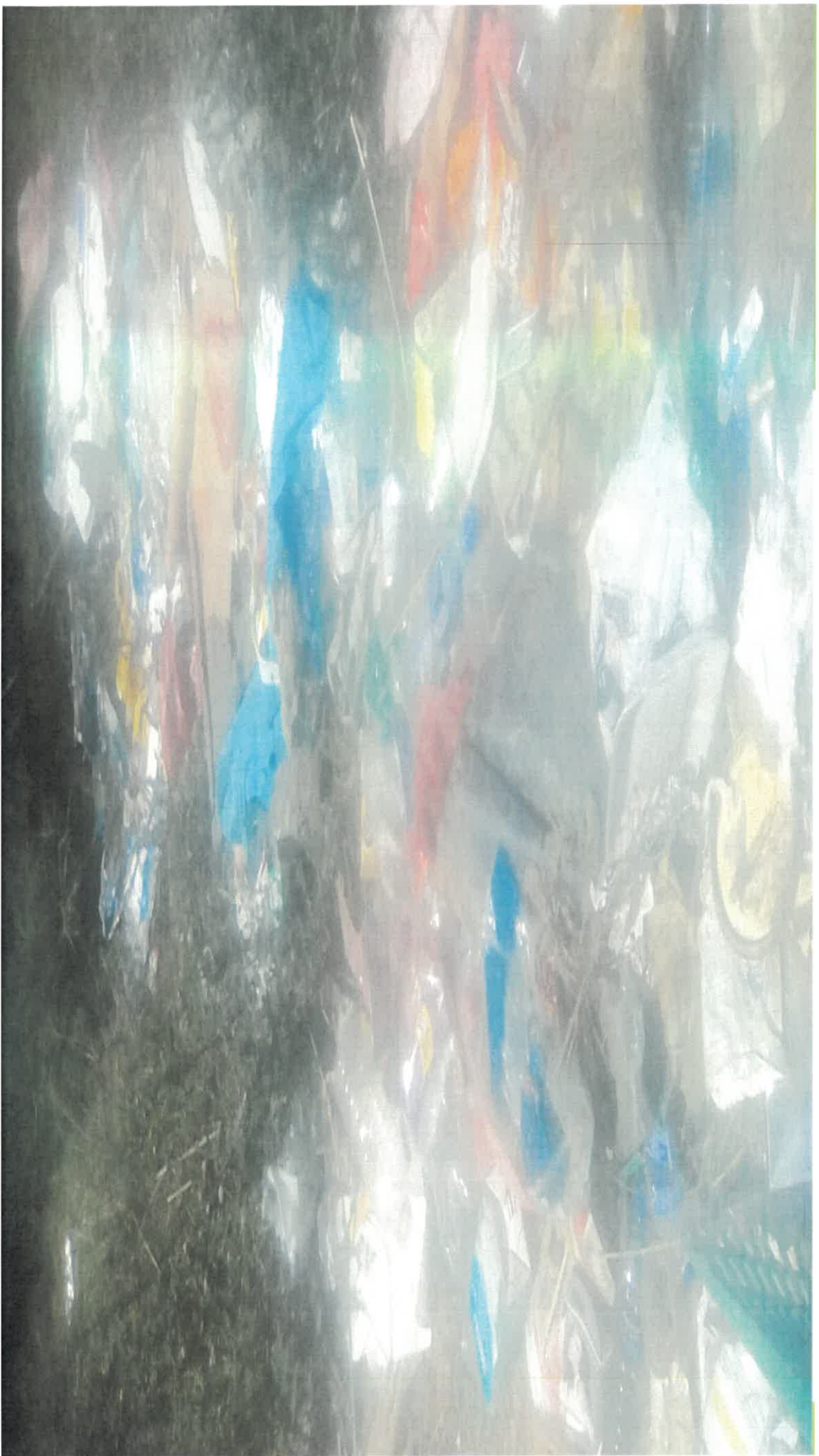

► METHODOLOGY :

- ➡ The key strategy for the project's progress is the division of labour and a concrete work plan.
- ➡ The team has the following strategies to accomplish that: The team is divided into two groups demographically selected (in accordance to the activity) and is then again subdivided into factions of five teams with three individuals per team in which every member has an assigned tasks so that the project will work efficiently.
- ➡ The Theewaterskloof Villiersdorp Cleaning Service cleaning activity will be done every month.
- ➡ The Community with the cleanest surroundings will receive an award and a banner for recognition.
- ➡ We as a human being, each of us is very important, if we can do something good for the community, why don't we do it, our willingness to help is free, just get it done and complete and ensure that it is finished in a proper way and bringing things in order.
- ➡ Learned how to be independent, doing our own control without depending on someone.
- ➡ We also engage things with preparedness and diligence in our actions and concerning for the better result.
- ➡ It is very important to make ways on cleaning because the more we ignore just like a simple cleaning, it can affect the environment and also a big effect to our health and we will never notice it immediately until sooner when it's already severe and too late to seek for help.
- ➡ Having a clean environment helps us to have a clean source of fresh water, natural foods to eat, risk free place, hazards and to save animals and other endangered species.

- Opening and cleaning of catch pits and stormwater drainage to reduce flooding due to the impact of heavy rain and waste in Villiersdorp

- ▶ We also make sure to remove all garden waste as per our service to keep our Town clean and our service times are from Monday to Friday from 8h00 until 16h00.
- ▶ Monday we do the whole Buitekant street, Graaff Street, Huguenot Street, Victoria Street, Mainroad from Betko Cross till the Bridge at Vilko Up until the back of De Villiers Graaf Primary and the Grave Yards.
- ▶ Tuesday we do all the other streets in ward 5 : Boland str; Muller Str, Voortrekker Str, Prince Albert Str, Uppington Str
- ▶ The world would be a cleaner place — this is why A Neighborhood Cleanup was created.
